CALL FOR PAPER

The aim of 1st Student Research Symposium at ICDCIT 2011 is to stimulate and foster student research at undergraduate, graduate, and PhD levels. This will provide an international forum for highlighting student research accomplishments in Distributed Computing and Internet technology. All topics relevant to ICDCIT, and listed in ICDCIT 2011 CFP (www.icdcit.ac.in), are of interest to this symposium. This is best suited for students who already have a plan outlined for their work in the broad areas of Distributed Computing and Internet Technology. This forum will provide a friendly and supportive environment for students to present and discuss their research both with their peers and with a panel of experienced researchers from academia and industry. In addition to providing feedback and advice, this forum will provide an opportunity for students to network as well as to practice presenting their research clearly and concisely.

SUBMISSIONS

The symposium will be an event consisting of paper as well as poster presentations. Submissions will be put through a review process and the selected ones will be invited for presentations in the form of papers or posters.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Intended participants must submit their technical contents that must contain the participant's name, affiliation, advisor's name (if known), theme of research, degrees obtained so far, current status in their degree, and expected graduation date. The write-up should be a concise description of the problem statement, scientific and technical approach, and the results obtained so far. Sufficient information should be provided for the chairs and the review board to judge the merit of the research. The submissions should be in PDF format. The write up should be presented in IEEE format with page limit not more than 6 pages. And the papers should be sent to symposium@kiit.ac.in
